Background

What we did

We were commissioned to deliver Clinical Output Specifications, develop an initial schedule of accommodation and review exemplar room drawings for a number of programmes of care which included:

- Planned Care
- Unplanned Care
- Oncology Services
- Diagnostics
- Renal Services
- Emergency Services
- Chronic Disease Management
- Day Surgery Services

The clinical output specifications were delivered through undertaking a series of workshops with end users and developing a report for each of the programmes of care which could be in turn integrated into the overarching technical brief. The specifications are also to be used to form the basis of operational policies for each of the programmes of care.

Outcome

- Delivery of clinical output specifications for 8 programmes of care
- Information was used to inform the overarching technical brief which will be used in the appointment process of the developer
- Development of the functional content and schedule of accommodation for the new build elements of the project
- All deliverables were delivered to the tight deadline with no delays
- Review of exemplar room drawings as undertaken to ensure optimum use of space and functionality
